

ESU 2019 Doctoral Programme - GRADING SYSTEM

We estimate that **6 ECTS** equal 180 hours of study time, which is divided as follows:

- ✓ Writing an Abstract - 10h
- ✓ Writing the paper - 65h
- ✓ Reviewing a paper - 20h
- ✓ Reading the literature on the reading list - 20h
- ✓ Attending the conference and presenting the paper - 40h
- ✓ Writing a max. 5 page report on what you have learned during the conference and how you will incorporate this into your future research - 25h
