

ESU 2021 Doctoral Program Syllabus

Physical attendance & Online

The ESU online doctoral program consists of **4 ECTS** equal 112 hours of study time, which are divided as follows:

- Writing an Abstract - 10h
- Extending the abstract into a full paper - 50h
- Reading the literature on the reading list and creating questions to speakers - 20h
- Reviewing papers of other participants - 20h
- Discussing feedback within your track - 4h
- Attending mandatory keynote sessions (five in total) - 7h
- Writing a summary of your experience at ESU- 1h

The ESU doctoral program on site consists of **6 ECTS** equal to 168 hours of study time, which are divided as follows:

- Writing an Abstract - 10h
- Extending the abstract into a full paper - 50h
- Reading the literature on the reading list and creating questions to speakers - 20h
- Reviewing papers of other participants - 20h
- Discussing feedback within your track - 4h
- Attending the full week of the conference and presenting paper (including keynote speakers sessions, attending cultural/practitioner visits) – 50h
- Writing a summary of your experience at ESU including reflections from the visits and attendance to the conference- 14h

An ESU 2021 certificate will be awarded to those who complete the above activities within the timetable detailed below. Please follow the deadlines diligently because the program is highly interconnected and based on peer feedback. Missing deadlines without notice will be interpreted as dropping out of the program.
