Instruction to write your paper:

In order to limit the amount of effort and guarantee a similar workload for all participants (both in writing the paper and in reviewing the assigned paper), we strongly recommend that papers submitted are no longer than the following (main text, excluding references):

- Research proposal (Early-stage group): 2.500 words.
- Work in progress research (Work in progress group): 4.000 words.
- Results paper (Mature group): 4.000 words.

Workload for the ESU2023 Doctoral Program and Grading criteria:

We estimate that 6 ECTS equal 180 hours of study time, which is divided as follows:

- Writing an Abstract - 10h
- Writing the paper - 65h
- Reviewing a paper - 20h
- Reading the literature on the reading list - 20h
- Attending the conference and presenting the paper - 40h
- Writing a max. 5-page report on what you have learned during the conference and how you will incorporate this into your future research - 25h
